With reference to your application for the purpose mentioned in the subject cited above. I am directed to inform you that on the basis of the inspection committee report and as per recommendations of the Board of Inspection (BoI) dated 28.04.2025 constituted for this purpose, the University has decided to grant provisional affiliation to your college in the courses mentioned below for the academic session 2025-26, for the seats mentioned against the said course.

The admission process can be started on compliance the same.

		Fresh provisional affiliation of LL.M. Two Year Degree Course 40 seats (one section) be granted/ recommended.	
Note: - 1. The College should strictly follow the admission guideline and syllabus prescribed by the University for all Law Courses, available on the University website. 2. No admission will be made by the college against the intake recommended seats unless BCI approval is obtained in the session 2025-26.			

Accordingly, the college is required to adhere to the following:

- That if college already has a valid approval of BCI for the session 2025-26, it can start the process of admission against the approved seats immediately after issuance of this letter.
- That if the college does not have a valid approval of BCI for the session 2025-26, it is mandatorily required to obtain the BCI approval, or to deposit the requisite fee to BCI, within one month of issuance of this letter, for its inspection/ approval for the session 2025-26 and proof of the same should be submitted to the University. The admission process can be started on compliance of the same.
- That the necessary compliance with regard to remark/ recommendations made by the inspection committee must be ensured within the prescribed time limit i.e. two months from the date of issuance of this letter, failing which, the proposal of the college for affiliation for the session 2026-27 will not be considered.
- That the University by virtue of its authority may exercise the power to inspect the college any time and if found violating the above-mentioned norms, the college will be liable to face the consequences.
- The provision of 10% (Ten Percent) seats for EWS category for BA LL. B and LL.B. course will be in accordance to the policy of Bar Council India (BCI) and with specific approval sought from the BCI by the college.
